### STADIUM SPECTATOR RULES

***During the Covid-19 pandemic, athletic events must be conducted in a manner that is unprecedented. Rules MUST be followed by ALL those in attendance, including spectators. While athletic events have traditionally been community social events, this year's focus will be exclusively on the football/soccer game on the field.***

- Tailgating on the KCHS campus is strictly prohibited.
- **All Tickets for home football games must be purchased online using the GoFan app. No paper tickets will be sold at the KCHS stadium ticket booth.**
- Please do not purchase tickets for yourself or members of your family if you do not have a genuine interest in watching the football/soccer game.
- Ticket Gates for spectators will not open until 1-hour prior to beginning of game/match.
- Stadium seating capacity is 690. However, spectators are permitted to bring chairs to sit on the track in (clearly marked) designated areas, keeping in mind social distancing guidelines still apply.
- KCHS will limit the total amount of fans at each home game to allow for recommended social distancing. KCHS reserves the right to close gates when approaching max capacity.
- **FACE COVERINGS MUST BE WORN BY ALL SPECTATORS AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE STADIUM, AND WHILE STANDING AT THE TICKET GATE TO ENTER THE STADIUM.** Spectators who refuse to adhere to this guideline will be asked to leave.
- Temperatures will be taken before being allowed to enter the stadium. Temperatures over 100.4 will not be allowed entry into the stadium.
- Bleachers have been marked with X's where fans are expected to sit and maintain social distancing.
- Children are REQUIRED to sit with their family at all times and will NOT be permitted to "roam" about the stadium unattended.
- Spectators are not permitted to bring balls or other toys to any athletic event.
- Spectators are not permitted to bring outside food or drinks to any athletic event.
- Only "essential" personnel will be permitted to stand on or near the sidelines, including players and coaches, cheerleaders, dance team members, managers, trainers and medical staff, administration, and approved members of media.
- KCHS will strictly enforce the stadium's NO RE-ENTRY policy. Spectators will NOT be permitted to exit the stadium gates and then re-enter.
- **Under no circumstance will spectators from the home or visiting schools be permitted on the field after the game.**
- All spectators are expected to exit the facility shortly after the conclusion of the game, and NOT congregate inside the stadium gates, outside of the stadium, or any part of the KCHS campus.
- Failure of spectators to adhere to these rules will result in being removed from the facility and will affect the ability to attend future events at KCHS.
